Tom is a member of the Oil Painters of America and enjoys painting plein air on location and from photos in the studio. He is influenced by the American, French and Russian impressionists. He uses fresh confident brushstrokes and captures the form, mood and light with a strong colorful design.

David and his wife own an art studio on the North side of Chicago, Vitruvian Fine Art Studio where they teach drawing, painting and sculpting.

WORKSHOP APPLICATION --INFORMATION AND FEES

The Northbrook Arts Commission in collaboration with The Northbrook Park District will hold three fine art workshops in the spring of 2012. They will be taught by experienced workshop art instructors who are well known regionally and nationally. The classes will include: Watercolor painting, Oil painting and realistic drawing and painting art work instruction and be **open to all levels of artists**. Class size is limited so don't delay sending in your registration. The workshop times are 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day with an hour for lunch.

Fee: \$175 for one workshop, two or more workshops are \$150 each, tuition does not include the cost of art supplies. To register for a workshop, fill out this form, make copy for your records and return it with the required fee.

Transfers: \$40.00 fee will be charged to the student, to transfer enrollment from one workshop to another for all circumstances. The transfer must be requested no less than 30 days prior to the beginning of a requested class and is subject to availability.

Refunds: No refunds of any kind will be made for no shows or for cancellations made less than 30 days prior to the beginning of the class. Students who stop attending during class without prior approval will forfeit all claims for tuition refund or credit.

Cancellations: *Northbrook Arts Commission has the right to cancel a class due to insufficient enrollment or due to circumstances beyond their control. If cancellation is necessary, all tuition will be refunded. If space is available, transfer options will be offered at no extra fee to the student.*

Students who cancel after registration will be charged a \$75.00 fee for each canceled workshop. Students who wish to cancel must notify the chairperson* for this event by telephone or in person. Email or phone messages left on answering machine are not acceptable forms of cancellation. The remaining balance of workshop funds will be returned if cancellation occurs no less than 30 days prior to the beginning of the class.

Supplies: Students are advised to bring their own supplies and easels. A supply list for each class the student has enrolled will be sent prior to the class (es).

Meals: There will be one hour for lunch, several restaurants and other fast food outlets are located across the park from the Village Green Center.
